The first system of the piece consists of two staves in 4/4 time. The right hand plays a sequence of quarter notes: C4 (finger 1), D4 (finger 2), E4 (finger 3), F4 (finger 4), G4 (finger 5), and F4 (finger 3). The left hand plays a sequence of quarter notes: F3 (finger 5), E3 (finger 4), D3 (finger 3), C3 (finger 2), B2 (finger 1), and C3 (finger 3).

The second system continues the piece. The right hand plays: C4 (finger 1), D4 (finger 2), E4 (finger 3), F4 (finger 4), and G4 (finger 2). The left hand plays: F3 (finger 5), E3 (finger 4), D3 (finger 3), C3 (finger 2), and B2 (finger 4).

The third system continues the piece. The right hand plays: C4 (finger 1), D4 (finger 2), E4 (finger 3), F4 (finger 4), G4 (finger 5), and F4 (finger 3). The left hand plays: F3 (finger 5), E3 (finger 4), D3 (finger 3), C3 (finger 2), B2 (finger 1), and C3 (finger 3).

The fourth and final system of the piece. The right hand plays: C4 (finger 4), D4 (finger 3), E4 (finger 4), F4 (finger 2), and G4 (finger 1). The left hand plays: F3 (finger 2), E3 (finger 3), D3 (finger 2), C3 (finger 4), and B2 (finger 5). The piece concludes with a double bar line.
